The new P5 Archive App by Archiware is a result of such a challenge.

Since most media professionals and companies constantly struggle with storage capacity, Archiving helps them to move files and assets out of the way. This creates free space for new productions.

How can you simplify Archiving to the max?

Archive from the Finder using a right-click is the answer. And that is what the P5 Archive App does.

When you have completed a

production or delivered it to your customer, simply right-click on the respective folder and off it goes. Only a small archive link file remains with the name of the original file or folder.

This archive link can be copied to any folder. When double clicked, a media preview is shown including the metadata fields of the archive and a restore button.

When restored, the file will be sent to the location where the archive link resides.

FCP X Support

Archiving FCP X Libraries even traces potential external media to include them in the archive. This way all relevant media will be available after restore.

P5 Archive, which runs in the background on the connected server, is very powerful and flexible. It can be configured to create cloned tapes for maximum security, to import metadata from the file header of archived files. It also has a browser based interface

for searching and browsing the complete archive catalog including previews of all media.

As a result, archive is as close to the actual users as possible and as easy as one right-click. They are the ones that know when they have finished an edit or a project. When they suffer from storage space constraints, they can now trigger the archiving process themselves. Administrators are freed of the task of chasing completed media productions that clog the storage. Everybody wins.

Since P5 Archive is part of the

the P5 suite it can be combined with P5 Synchronize for cloning, P5 Backup for backup to disk and tape and P5 Backup2Go for workstation backup. P5 runs on Mac, Win, Linux, Solaris and FreeBSD. A 30 day free trial version is available.

The P5 Archive App needs P5 Archive plus one workstation client to run.
